The World Bank is supporting the Government of Moldova in the implementation of two distinct but complementary projects: REMAP and TerraMoldova funded by the Global Environment Facility (GEF). While the two projects are technically separate operations — each with its own financing, results framework, and implementation arrangements — they are designed to work in synergy to address Moldova's land and environmental management challenges at scale.

REMAP is aiming to address the critical issue of land-based nutrient pollution in the Dniester River Basin while advancing sustainable landscape management practices. Its overarching objective is to expand the area under sustainable landscape management practices and restore the ecological integrity of the Dniester River Basin. By improving wetland, forest, and river ecosystem functions in the catchment area, the project aims to enhance water filtration, nutrient retention, and habitat connectivity, while promoting biodiversity and building resilience to climate change. The initiative incorporates Nature-Based Solutions (NBS) to address nutrient pollution and improve ecosystem quality and connectivity. It aligns with Moldova's commitments under EU environmental directives and international frameworks, including the Kunming-Montreal Global Biodiversity Framework and the UN Decade on Ecosystem Restoration.

National Office for the Implementation of Environmental Projects (NOIEP) now invites eligible individual consultants (“Consultants”) to indicate their interest in providing the Services related to financial management of the Project. Interested Consultants should provide information demonstrating that they have the required qualifications and relevant experience to perform the Services.

The minimum qualifications for this position are:

Educational Background:

- University degree in accounting, finance, economics, public administration, or a related field.

Professional Experience:

- At least 10 years of practical experience in financial management and disbursement processes within projects funded by the World Bank, IFI and/or other international financial institutions.
- Demonstrated in-depth knowledge of the IFI's financial management (including World bank's financial policies) and disbursement policies, procedures, and guidelines.

Specific Expertise:

- Experience with the preparation and submission of financial reports compliant with international donor requirements, particularly the World Bank.
- Familiarity with financial management software and tools commonly used in internationally funded projects.
- Knowledge and practical experience working with the World Bank's online systems, such as Client Connection, is an advantage.

Language and Technical Skills:

- Advanced proficiency in Romanian and English (both spoken and written).
- Excellent knowledge of computer applications, including MS Office Suite (Excel, Word, PowerPoint) and financial management software.

Additional Skills:

- Strong analytical and problem-solving skills.
- Excellent organizational abilities and attention to detail.
- Ability to communicate effectively and work collaboratively with diverse stakeholders.
